Tour program Hanoi – Halong – Saigon – Cu Chi (6 Days/ 5 nights)

Day 01: Hanoi arrival - Halong (L, D)

Arrive Hanoi by flight from Bangkok. You will be welcome by our guide and driver at the airport then transferred to city for lunch. PM. Drive to Halong Bay. Tour briefing and information provided by the local guide on the bus so that you can be more confident yourself when crossing the traffic! Upon arrival Halong, check-in hotel. Welcome dinner at restaurant and get to know "Vietnamese cuisines". Overnight in Halong.

Day 02: Halong – Hanoi (B,L,D)

Breakfast at hotel. Check-out and transfer to the port for a magical 4 hours aboard your boat cruising around the Bay. Considered Vietnam's greatest natural wonder, Halong Bay boasts over 3,000 islands that jut out of the sea to provide a spectacular natural environment. We admire its beauty and scale before stopping at one of the many secluded bays for a refreshing swim (weather permitting). We also take the opportunity to enjoy a fresh seafood lunch on board our boat. This afternoon travel back to Hanoi. Some shopping or orientation tour. Dinner. Enjoy water puppet show. Overnight. (B,L,D)

Day 03: Hanoi city tour – Saigon (B,L,D)

This morning we begin our look at Hanoi by visiting the Ho Chi Minh Quarter. Ho Chi Minh is without question one of the great figures of twentieth century history and we'll take time to look at the life of the father of modern Vietnam. We'll start with a visit to the Ho Chi Minh mausoleum - set on the spot in Ba Dinh Square where Ho Chi Minh first declared independence from French rule in 1945. We'll then visit the humble house on stilts from which Uncle Ho as he is affectionately known, ruled Vietnam until his death in 1969. Continue on to the intriguing Ho Chi Minh Museum, an amazing surreal exhibition of the life of Ho Chi Minh, set in the context of major events of the twentieth century and Vietnam's struggle for independence. We'll also view the Presidential Palace and One Pillar Pagoda. We continue our tour by visiting Hanoi's first University - the Temple of Literature - dating back to 1070. This historical center of learning is now dedicated to Confucian worship. Lunch. PM. Continue visit Hanoi with Ngoc Son temple, Swrod Lake, old quarter of Hanoi. Shopping. Transfer to airport for flight to HoChiMinh city - VN781/783 (17:00-19:00). Pick-up at the airport and transfer to dinner. Overnight in Saigon.

Day 04: Saigon (B,L,D)

Breakfast at hotel. Day for exploring Saigon: You will be accompanied by our local guide for a walking tour of Saigon most famous and historic city landmark -through the heart of the city along Dong Khoi Street (formerly Rue Catinat), past the Rex Hotel, Ho Chi Minh Square, Municipal Theatre and Notre Dame Cathedral. Following a tour of the Reunification Palace (formerly the Presidential Palace) and War Remnants Museum we drive to Cholon, the Chinatown district of the city where we visit the huge Binh Tay wholesale market and the ornate Thien Hau Pagoda, dedicated to the Goddess of the Sea. Lunch at local restaurant. Dinner cruise on Saigon river. Overnight in Saigon.

Day 05: Saigon - Cu Chi (B,L,D)

Breakfast at hotel. Morning excursion to the Cu Chi tunnels located in an area known during the Vietnam War as the Iron Triangle on account of the strength of its Communist insurgency. The Cu Chi tunnel network was established as a means of waging guerrilla war against superior French and later American firepower. The network stretches over 250km and extends to three levels underground providing a remarkable insight into the method and determination of Communist forces during the Vietnam War. Return to Saigon for lunch. PM. Continue to visit Saigon. Dinner. Overnight in Saigon

Day 06: Saigon -Departure (B,L,)

Breakfast at hotel. Morning excursion to the Opera House, Notre Dame Cathedral & Central Post Office Lunch. shopping at Ben Thanh market .
Transfer to airport End of tour
