

Middle School Classes


Middle School begins from the fifth standard and ends in the seventh standard. When the pupils step to the fifth standard, they have to make a very serious decision—whether they will take the Burma matriculation examination or the G.C.E. (General Certificate of Education, London University) given by the British Council in Rangoon.

The decision is taken into consideration by the teachers as well as the parents. When the decision is made, the G.C.E. students and the matriculation students are divided into two separate classes. The matric students have their medium of instruction in Burmese, while the G.C.E. students study in English, with three other language choices—Burmese, Hindi or French.


At the end of the seventh standard, the matric students sit for the annual Seventh Standard Government Examinations, which comes two years before their high school final matriculation exams. If they pass the latter exams, they are then qualified to enroll at Rangoon University.

There are 10 Middle School classes in our school. Two of them which meet in afternoon school are Standards V D and V E. The remaining eight, which meet in the Morning school, are Standards V A, V B and V C Standard VI A, VI B, and VI C, and Standards VII A and VII B.


