

SCHOOL RULES

1956-57

Revised and amended school rules adopted for the 1956-57 school year are as follows:

1. In the corridors (a) keep to the left; (b) walk in single or double file; (c) be silent. (Talking is allowed in the corridors before school starts and during recess, but there must be no crowding).
2. There must be perfect silence after the first bell in the morning and during assembly.
3. There must be no running up or down the steps or in the corridors. This means before and after school as well.
4. No one is allowed to drink water at the fountains after the second bell at recess.
5. During recess there must be no eating in the corridors. Food may be eaten in the classrooms or in the tuckshop.
6. No one is allowed to buy food from outside hawkers.
7. All litter must be thrown in the baskets or tins provided.
8. No one is allowed to play on the lawns or in the church grounds.
9. Children must wear the prescribed school uniform. Shoes and not slippers must be worn.
10. While in school, children should converse in English only.
11. There must be no scribbling on the walls in any part of the school.
12. Tops, rubber-rings, catapults and comics must not be brought to school. They will be confiscated.
13. There must be no cycling in the school grounds or passages during school hours.
14. Children responsible for breakages of school property will have to pay for repairs.
15. Children wanting to leave school during school hours must bring a written request from their parents. The Principal will then grant permission.
